Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ!

"I am reminded of your sincere faith, a faith that dwelt first in your grandmother Lois and your mother Eunice and now, I am sure, dwells in you as well."

"But as for you, continue in what you have learned and have firmly believed, knowing from whom you learned it and how from childhood you have been acquainted with the sacred writings, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus," (2 Timothy 1:5; 3:14-15, ESV).

Just over forty years ago, my mother was killed in a tragic car accident. After some years of wandering, the grace of Jesus found me and brought me back to Him. As my connection with Him grew and developed, it became more important for me to know about my mother's faith. As a young child, I distinctly remember my mom taking me to Vacation Bible Schools at various churches and being sure I knew Jesus Christ. Though she always made sure I had a Bible, took me to VBS, and to church, she did not talk about her own faith at all. While going through some old books, I came across her childhood Bible and found many notes about her faith and love for Jesus. As a young child, she was definitely brought up in the faith. And though she wasn't great at articulating her own faith, she made the effort to be sure I knew Jesus.

Lois and Eunice took the lead in making sure young Timothy was raised up in the faith, just as I'm sure my grandmother taught my mother, who took the lead in raising me up in the faith as well. As I reflect on my life, I would have little or nothing to do with Jesus if my mother (and my father as well) hadn't given me the Bible and made sure I was in church on Sundays. As Paul calls on Timothy to know "from whom you learned it," we also remember and give thanks for those who acquainted us with the powerful Word of God.

Who is your Lois and Eunice? We know that the Scripture makes us wise unto salvation, but someone begins our journey in the Bible. It may be our parents, it might be a friend who invited us to youth group or Sunday school, or it might be a neighbor who invited us to come to church. As you consider your faith in Jesus today, give thanks to those who passed on the Word to you.

On Sunday, August 30, Ascension will host Friendship Sunday with one service at 10:30am and a potluck following. Could you be the Lois or Eunice in the life of another person if you invite them to our service and fellowship? Who knows, maybe someone in the distant future will look back and remember you as the one who acquainted them with the "sacred writings, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus."

- ◇ First steps include reviewing current procedures and setting up training for ushers, Elders and Worship Assistants, and anyone else who wants to know CPR and AED (Automatic External Defibrillator) basics
- ◇ New procedures will be considered on monitoring exits before, during, and after events and worship
- ◇ We will also seek support from local law enforcement on best practices
- ◇ The committee's goal is to ensure a safe environment for our church by having a single source guide for emergency procedures along with training

• Wyatt Brown (seminarian)

- ◇ Wyatt and Katherine arrived in St. Louis, moved into their apartment on June 13, and Wyatt began his first summer Greek class on June 15
- ◇ The Voters Assembly on May 31 agreed to give \$2400 a year to the scholarship program for Concordia Seminary, St. Louis, which supports all residential seminarians preparing for pastoral ministry
- ◇ Ascension will also be sending monthly support directly to Wyatt from the Chuck Abshire Seminary Fund

• Property Management

- ◇ A project to remove playground equipment, refurbishing the playground area to accommodate picnic tables, a permanent outdoor grill, and other upgrades is underway with help from the Iron Men group
 - * We are in the process of getting bids to resurface the area, and if you know someone with excavation equipment, the cost would go down considerably
 - * Conceptual drawings include a concrete slab under the shelter with built-in BBQ, pavers and artificial turf in the outdoor area, along with picnic tables
- ◇ Installation of speakers and sound system in the Community Room complete
- ◇ Narthex carpet replaced and all walls painted throughout

PROPERTY MANAGEMENT REPORT

New flooring has been installed in the Narthex, hallways, nursery and new LVP installed in two bathrooms. The walls have been painted in the same areas with the exception of the women's bathroom which will be completed at a later date.

On June 5, I met with a representative of The Energy Trust of Oregon for his assessment of updating the rest of our fluorescent tube lighting to new LED fixtures. We are awaiting the results and then we can schedule with Cox Electric to get the job done. This program is a direct result of the money that is paid by all of us through our electric bill – so in essence, we would actually benefit from something we are already paying.

New water supply lines and water turn off valves have been purchased for the toilets in the men's and women's bathrooms. We are looking for someone to install them so that the parts are new and less likely to leak. There is a small leak under the sink in the men's room and we plan to have that and the men's urinal fixed when the plumber swaps out the supply lines/valves.

We have reserved a truck from Shred NW to be

onsite August 1st from 10:00am to 1:00pm at Ascension to shred documents. Members of Ascension and the community are invited to drop by their documents that need shredding. The shredding is done on-site.

The pool table has been sold. The youth group fund is now \$120 richer.

The old blue LW Hymnals are located under the mailboxes. Please feel free to take one if you wish.

We continue to clean and purge obsolete items that have been taking up space in various closets. The closet next to the Narthex entry stores extra tables, chairs, ice melt to clear the walk and steps of ice/snow, ladders, a wheelchair, etc – all things that would be needed at the spur of the moment.

The front door has been repaired.

One of the landscape sprinklers decided to go rogue, Victor Alvarado repaired it.

There are still remnants of the play area that need to be disposed of.
