# CHRISTIAN OBITUARY

## Patrick Michael Fogarty

### December 9, 1958 – January 21, 2026



Patrick Michael Fogarty passed away peacefully on January 21, 2026.

Patrick Michael Fogarty, son of Patrick Matthew Fogarty and Bonnie Lucille Thomen Fogarty, was born in Portland, Oregon, on December 9, 1958, and died on January 21, 2026, at the age of 67 years, one month, and twelve days.

Mike was baptized in Galata, Montana at Galata Lutheran Church on May 1, 1983, and confirmed in Portland, Oregon at Ascension Lutheran Church on January 1, 1991, and was a member of Ascension Lutheran Church at the time of his death.

Mike was united in marriage to Linda Kirchner at Ascension Lutheran Church on July 12, 1980, where they made their home in Gresham, Oregon. Four children were born to their union: Timothy James, Trever Nicholas, Ty Joseph, and Joel Daniel Fogarty.

Mike served his Lord through his local congregation as high school youth director. He took them on various youth trips including the beach, Mount Hood, and Mount Bachelor. He made sure they attended the National Youth Gatherings in Texas, Florida, and Georgia. Mike and Merci started the Sporting, Soaring, and Scoring Soccer Clinic and servant event that included a week-long camp. It brought in high school kids from all over the country to teach soccer and spread the work of Christ to children 3 years old to 8th grade. The soccer clinic began in 2004 and ended in 2019, with thousands of people shown God's grace in Christ.

Mike followed his father's career, and in 1980 he was hired on to the Portland Fire Department. He loved being a firefighter and was proud to serve the city of Portland. He served 28 years until a stroke caused him to retire at age 50. Mike loved to coach his boys in all sports, including football, soccer, basketball, and baseball. He met many amazing kids and parents of kids and built lasting relationships. Mike was always involved in something. The bigger the project, the more he loved it. He loved to travel, and most of all he wanted to make sure everyone else travels too. His great joy was planning and making sure everyone was having a lot of fun.

Preceding Mike in death are Patrick Matthew Fogarty, father; Alan Conrad Kirchner, father-in-law; Timothy James (TJ) Fogarty, son.

Surviving to mourn the death are mother, Bonnie Fogarty; wife, Linda Fogarty; children, Trever Fogarty, Ty Fogarty (Nichole), Joel Fogarty (Ashley); grandchildren, Madison, Ethan, Grace, Lily, Peyton, Parker, and Paxton; sisters, Colleen Fogarty, Sharon Bartle (Ken), Diane Gingerich (Tom).
